From the Classroom of Miss Lauren, Miss Jen, and Miss Chelsea


"What's the weather, what's the weather, what's the weather everyone?..." On any given day, when you walk into the 34Q classroom you will hear this song being sung. It is part of our daily calendar/circle time. We have our children look out the windows to tell us if it is windy, cloudy, rainy or sunny. We then have one of our students mark the appropriate weather for the day on our calendar. We truly enjoy being mini meteorologists every day!

For the month of March, we have been exploring the phrase "In like a lion out like a lamb." After our weather song we ask the students if it is a "lion day" (cold, windy, rainy/snowy) or a "lamb day" (warm, sunny). We have been marking these days on our calendar every day (unfortunately we've had more lion than lamb). For the month of April we will explore the phrase "April showers bring May flowers." We will chart the rainy days in April to see if it truly is a rainy month.
